THEME OVERVIEW

Concept is a modern, flexible and easy to use theme for your business or portfolio site.

- Theme compatible with latest WordPress version.
- Portfolio page template.
- Blog page template.
- Full width page template.
- Post thumbnail feature.
- Custom menu navigation system, multi-level dropdown
- Background customization panel.
- Theme options panel.
- Front page slider.
- Gallery slider in portfolio entries
- Custom shortcodes.
- Three widget ready locations
- Threaded comments.
- Integrated blog pagination.
- Cross-browser compatible.
- Delivered with .png source files (.psd files available in the forum)

HOW TO INSTALL THE THEME

Please unzip the '[concept_unzip_first.zip](#)' file that you received.

The theme is the '[concept.zip](#)' file inside the folder. In your WordPress administration area, go to 'Appearance - Themes'. In the top there appears a new tab navigation. Click on the 'Install Themes' tab, then click the 'Upload' item in the new menu and browse for the '[concept.zip](#)' file in your computer and after locating it press the 'Install Now' button and after that 'activate' the new theme.

You can also install this theme the traditional way, by unzipping the '[concept.zip](#)' file, and upload the theme folder using an ftp client to the '[wp-content/themes](#)' folder of your WordPress installation.

After installing the theme, go to '[Appearance-Themes](#)' in your WordPress administrator area, and click the '[activate](#)' link of the newly installed theme. The theme is now the active one.

THE THEME OPTIONS PANEL

This theme comes with an options panel that allows you to configure some aspects of the theme without touching code. To access the options panel, in your WordPress administration area go to '[Appearance – Method Options](#)'. Please take a look at the different options you have there.

CHANGING THE LOGO

You can change the logo from the theme panel, by changing the 'Logo Image Url' with your new logo image url.

You can also switch to text logo from the theme panel. In this case your 'Site Title' will replace the logo.

CONFIGURING THE MENU

The theme uses in full the custom menu navigation system introduced in WordPress 3.0. There is one menu location in this theme: the 'Main Menu'.

You need to go to '[Appearance – Menus](#)' in your WordPress admin to start configuring your menu. You first need to create a menu in the right side and then from the left you can select the pages and categories you want to be part of each menu. Don't forget to click 'Save Menu' after you add the

items. *Note that you have to have created your pages and categories first and they will be available in the list to include in the menu.*

In the left you will see the active menu location and you need to assign the new menu to the location using the dropdown selection.

To enable dropdown in the menu interface, you have to drag the menu items below another menu item (child item).

USING THE THUMBNAIL FUNCTION

When you edit a post or a page, in the bottom of the right column you have a new area called *Featured Image*. Click on the [Set Featured Image](#) link and you will be taken in the image uploader interface, where you can upload or select one of the existing images. Make sure that after you view your image press the '[Use as Featured Image](#)' link. The image will be resized and cropped to fit your thumbnail size. The thumbnail is visible only in the category view. It will not be visible when viewing the full post. You can add the full sized image directly to your post if you want to.

THE FRONT PAGE SLIDER

You can include any page or post in the slider, by simply creating a custom field in the page/post. The custom field name should be '[slider](#)' and the value should be '[1](#)'. Custom fields area is located in the bottom of the screen when you edit a page/post. If your custom fields section is not visible, in the top right of your screen when you edit a page or post, you have a button named 'Screen Options', please click on it and enable the custom fields section. Note that you should use a different post/page for each slide.

When you include a page/post to the slider, by default the featured image will be used (min. size of used image should be 900x400px.), the title of the page/post will be the title of the slide, the excerpt of the page/post will be the caption and the slide will link to the page/post.

If you don't want the page title to be your slide title, you can create a custom field named '[slidetitle](#)' and in the value area enter the title you want.

If you don't want the excerpt to be used as the slide's caption, you can create a custom field name '[slidecaption](#)' and in the value field enter the caption you want.

If you don't want the slide to link to the page/post, you can create another custom field named '[slidelink](#)' and in the value area enter the url to be linked to. Please check the screenshot below for an overview of the custom fields.

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THE PORTFOLIO PAGE TEMPLATE

You need to create a category named [‘portfolio’](#). For each portfolio entry you need to create a post that belongs to the [‘portfolio’](#) category.

After that, create a page (you can name it whatever you want) and in the template selection dropdown in the right, select the [‘Portfolio Page’](#). You need to include this page in the menu if you want your portfolio to be reached from there.

In the full view of each portfolio post there is a gallery slider. The slider is enabled automatically. To add images to the gallery, all you need to do is add images to the post by clicking on the small [‘Upload/Insert’](#) icon above your editor. Do not show your images to the post, just add them (attach) to the post gallery and the slider will pick and resize them automatically.

In the theme panel you can change the effect and speed of the gallery slider and you can also control the amount of gallery entries that appear in the front page.

THE BLOG PAGE TEMPLATE

All you need to do is create a page and in the template selection dropdown in the right select [‘Blog Page’](#). Portfolio posts will be automatically excluded from the blog.

Alternatively you can include multiple categories in the menu if you want multiple blogs.

THE WIDGET AREAS OF THE THEME

This theme has three widget ready areas. The **FRONT WIDGET** is the widget in the front page just below the slider. The **BOTTOM WIDGET** is the widget in the bottom of your website, just above the footer area. The **RIGHT SIDEBAR** is the right bar visible in all pages. You can add widgets to each area by going into 'Appearance – Widgets' in your WordPress administration area and dragging & dropping widgets into each bar. Note that you can add as many widgets as you want to each area.

CUSTOM BACKGROUND PANEL

One of the new features introduced is the custom background that enables you to easily change the background color of your website or upload an image as your background.

To do so, in your WordPress admin go to 'Appearance – Background' and there you can easily make the necessary changes.
